RETURN AND EARN PROJECT FOR ADRA

ADRA Australia's response to Cyclone Idai in Malawi, Mozambique and Zimbabwe.

The ADRA network, with contribution from ADRA Australia, has been providing immediate assistance since Idai hit. Emergency funds have enabled ADRA to provide 6.5 tonnes of food, 1,000 shelter kits, 1,000 hygiene kits, and 2,000 tarps. One thousand households have also received water containers and chlorine to mitigate a cholera outbreak. It is feared that over 1,000 people have perished as a result of Idai.
