This Week's Reflection

A rest away from the world.

A passage that has been read over numerous of times is found in Mark 6:31 and the verse goes, 'And He said to them, "Come aside by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while." For there were many coming and going, and they did not even have time to eat'.

Now, what's important about this verse? To give you a perspective, the disciples had just come back from their task in spreading the gospel of repentance, healing the sick and performing various miracles in the name of Jesus. It would have been an exciting time to tell Jesus about what they would have done but it would have been exhausting as they returned from their work.

Jesus on the other hand would have been distraught after hearing the news of His cousin, John (the Baptist), was executed and realising His fate and the loss of a fellow labourer, you can feel the pressure facing Him and you can also see Jesus' human side as He asks the disciples to rest with Him.

Now many of us may not face what the disciples experienced or what Jesus experienced. Many of us are hard working, but many of us are hard working especially in this employment climate and social climate we live in. But there is an importance for us to rest and that is rest in Jesus from all the pressures in life. To go to that quiet place out in nature and reconnect in God's love. Spend time in His love, spend time in Jesus.
