This Week's Reflection

It is difficult for us to truly comprehend God's love. Our love is conditional. It has limits and those limits are tested by unfaithfulness. If someone you trust betrays you, you might be able to forgive and maybe even forget but if they betray you again, and again and continue to betray your trust, you will likely get to a point where you say enough. We can only handle so much betrayal. God on the other hand does not treat us this way. We may betray him and be unfaithful to him repeatedly, yet every time we come to Him with sincere repentance and ask Him for forgiveness, He not only forgives us but wipes away every unfaithful act on our part and starts the relationship afresh. The Bible says that he just cannot deny this part of who He is. God does not treat us the way we treat ourselves. So, if you ever feel like you have been too unfaithful to come back to God, remember He is waiting for you with open arms and if you stay close to Him, He will transform you and not only help you to be more faithful to Him but also to each other. He is always faithful.
