# Pastor's Comment

"In **Ezekiel 37:1-14** shares a really interesting and something worthwhile story as Seventh-day Adventists Christians. We find Ezekiel and the LORD in a valley full of dried bones. However, the LORD asks Ezekiel, "Son of man, can these bones live?" Ezekiel's humble response was "**O Lord God, You know**."

God requests Ezekiel to do something strange and unusual and that is to prophesy to these bones, However, God wanted Ezekiel to say something specific to these bones. So, Ezekiel says what the LORD tells him to say and as Ezekiel is speaking, verse 7 tells us that these bones rattled, the bones came together and flesh and skin came upon them.

Next, God tells Ezekiel to prophesy again, but this time to the Breath (or in this case, the Holy Spirit) to give life to these bodies and so Ezekiel does just that and these bodies are filled with the Holy Spirit and these bodies become alive.

Now, verse 11-14 tells us who these bones were and God's promise to His people. But, this message is important for us, Christians, because as people of the Book, we're called to go to a dying world where we are to prophesy to the dry bones of our community and call upon the Holy Spirit to bring life that they may have it abundantly (**John 10:10**).

Even if we think there is no hope for some dry bones, "O Lord God, You know." I pray this is our duty in these last days."
